### Application:

Students wishing to apply for an exchange semester/year need to fill in our online application. A separate nomination from the home university by email is required.

### Application & Nomination Deadline:

1<sup>st</sup> of May for Winter Semester or whole year  
1<sup>st</sup> of November for Summer Semester

### Academic Calendar:

(one month Orientation programme included)

Summer Semester:

March to July

Winter Semester:

September to February

### Departmental Coordinator:

Each of our departments has at least one Departmental Coordinator who will help with academic questions.

### Language of Instruction:

German or English (depending on the study program)

### Orientation Days and German Language Courses:

During our mandatory orientation, we will guide all exchange students through administrative processes and settling in. Cultural activities as well as a German language class (3 ECTS) are also part of the programme.

## Housing:

We offer support and assistance in finding housing. A limited number of rooms in student dorms is available for exchange students.

### Estimated Cost of Living – per month:

• Electricity	20,00 €
• Health insurance approx.	90,00 €
• Material for study	50,00 €
• Food, Clothing, etc.	320,00 €

### On time costs for the semester:

• Administrative Semester Fee	220,00 € (subject to change)
• Housing Deposit	450,00 €

A free bus ticket for buses, trams and local trains in the entire RMV-area (including most of the state of Hessen) is included in the Campus Card.
